

LEAF NET INSTALLATION

Read all instructions carefully before installation.

NOTE: If you live in a cold weather environment, plan on removing the leaf net BEFORE the pool water freezes.

FOR ABOVE GROUND POOLS:

1. Install your leaf net on top of winter cover. Place leaf net over the pool cover so it hangs over the side of the pool by 12".
2. Lace the pool cover cable through the grommets around the entire pool. (figure 2)
3. Insert one end of the cable through opening C (tension drum) from opposite directions (see illustration). Pull ends through until cable appears reasonably taut around pool edge. (figure 3)
4. To keep cable from slipping back, and to apply additional tension on the cable, ensuring that leaf net is securely fixed for the winter, turn the tension handle clockwise until cable is tight. The ratchet lock will automatically maintain the tension on the cable. It is important that the leaf net be installed properly and snugly so that the wind will not get under it, causing it to billow or flap and damage the leaf net.

NOTE: To loosen cable tension, simply turn the tension handle clockwise about 1/4 turn, lift and hold the ratchet lock out of its position and allow tension drum to unwind counterclockwise, releasing cable tension.

FOR IN-GROUND POOLS:

Refer to your pool cover instructions for proper winter cover installation.

1. Place leaf net over your pool so that it rests on the cover and hangs over the pool deck about 2'.
2. Insert empty water tubes into loops. The water tubes must cover the entire perimeter of the leaf net to prevent wind from getting under the leaf net and causing the leaf net to billow or flap.

CAUTION: Such billowing or flapping in the wind can cause serious damage to your leaf net. Therefore, be sure the water tubes are placed end to end as in figure 4.

3. Fill each water tube with water, to secure the leaf net to the pool decking. If you are in an area of extreme cold, fill the water bags only to half full to allow for ice expansion.

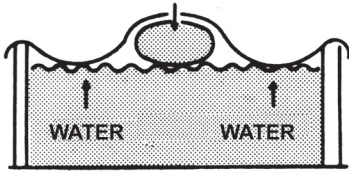

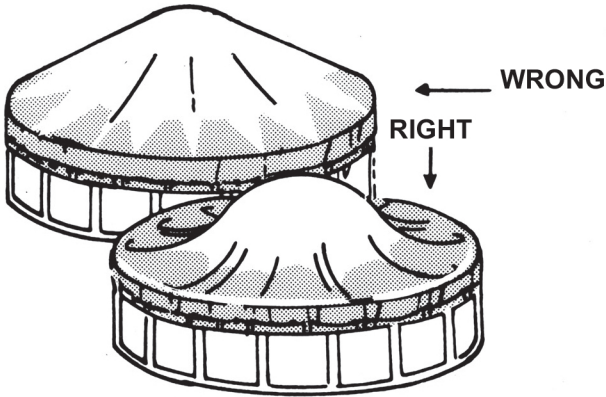
